- 4. Result announcement payment detail will be sent by late July 2022



Q1: Will the Summer School be cancelled if the outbreak of the pandemic gets worse or remains unstable?

A: Participants' health is always our top priority. We will keep updating participants on our latest decisions. If the situation becomes unstable, the Summer School will be conducted with alternate plans.

Q2: How do you ensure online training quality?

A: The Summer Schools offers a wide range of educational activities that encourage experimentation and practice. Participants will be motivated to learn in an online learning environment by interacting with different digital platforms and tasks. Group leaders will provide support and give guidance to students. Feedback from participants will also be collected daily to advance training effectiveness.

Q3: What precautions will you take to ensure a safe and clean environment for the physical sessions of Summer School?

A: In order to comply with the vaccination requirements for Specified Premises under Cap 599F, a third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine is required for participants. We will continue to monitor the developments of COVID-19 closely and follow the latest guidelines issued by the government and health authorities. Participants have to submit a health declaration every day. Participants who have a fever or respiratory symptoms will not be allowed to attend

the training. Please note that if a participant is notified by the government of medical authority to undergo a COVID-19 test, he/she must comply and should not attend the training until receiving a negative result.

Q4: Will hygienic tools be provided?

A: Hygienic materials such as hand sanitiser and surgical masks will be available on-site. Participants are advised to bring their own hygienic materials, which will also be provided upon request. The HKFYG Leadership Institute follows the government and health authorities' latest regulations and guidelines and registers visitors' details. The measures ensure the prioritisation of participants' health and safety.
