About Summer School for Global Leadership 2022

RESILIENT CITY PLANNER

With the global population living in urban cities projected to reach 66% by 2050, the building of sustainable and resilient cities has become a common focus across the world in the recent decade.

Being regarded as a megacity, Hong Kong is at high risk of natural hazards, such as flooding, typhoons, storm surges, and heatwaves. These events often trigger flooding and landslides, potentially causing devastating damage to the city. Besides, they are also suffering from chronic stresses like traffic congestion, pollution, and uncollected waste. In the wake of climate change, Hong Kong is vulnerable to encountering unpredictable climate anomalies and conceivably severe disasters.

Therefore, this year's Summer School will shed light on "Resilient City Planner", allowing participants to learn and contribute to the building of a more sustainable and resilient Hong Kong. Most importantly, a series of guest lectures, workshops, site visits and capstone projects will equip them to become future leaders with a global vision and commitment to initiate positive changes.



Roles Available for Recruitment

To make the School happen, we are now looking for passionate individuals with an eagerness to learn and a global mindset as our working team members. Two roles are available:

Group Leaders (Quota: 12)

Requirements

- University students preferred
- Fluent in spoken English
- Excellent communication and other teamwork skills
- **Experience in training, planning, leading or debriefing programme**
- Experience in organising summer school, orientation camps or any other educational workshops is a plus
- Overseas experience (e.g. study abroad, exchange programme, internship, etc.)
- Experience or knowledge in social and global issues /community engagement projects is a plus
- Legally permitted to work in Hong Kong

Duties

- To lead a group of 8 secondary school students in the 5-day Summer School
- To facilitate group discussions and debriefing before and after tasks
- To prepare for the **adventure-based challenges** and other team-building activities
- To assist students in advancing issues related to City Resilience
- To work with staff and organising committees of the School and facilitators to **optimise session flow**
- Any other ad hoc duties as required

Remuneration

Duties

- To **organise a 5-day Summer School** for 48 secondary school students
- To arrange community visits for students around Hong Kong (depending on the latest situation of the pandemic)
- To **liaise with renowned guest speakers** before and during the programme
- To manage on-site logistics arrangement and other ad-hoc support
